GREENTENNIS X TACKLING SUSTAINABILITY

GreenTennis focuses its efforts specifically upon making the sport of tennis more sustainable. However, it does not go unnoticed that there are many other sports out there contributing their fair share to waste and environmental deterioration. This is why GreenTennis has decided to join forces with Tackling Sustainability.

Founded by high school senior, Anjan Shroff, Tackling Sustainability places youth-led action at the forefront, creating a high school sports alliance that combats climate change. Apart from professional athletics, sport is primarily dominated by kids – and high school is the perfect time for students to make a difference within the communities that center around their passions. Tackling Sustainability serves as a platform to highlight projects spearheaded by youth leaders which bring forth climate solutions relating to a sport. The organization first began when Shroff conducted research using data analytics to optimize bus routes (to sports events and practices) at his school, The Latin School of Chicago, thus reducing carbon emissions significantly. Shroff hopes to recruit other ambassadors for Tackling Sustainability and grow the network of Gen Z'ers making an impacting in sports sustainability. Shroff spoke at the Green Sports Alliance's national summit in 2022 to raise awareness regarding the imperative for youth action beyond the measures pre-established by the older generations.

As a partner with Tackling Sustainability, GreenTennis hopes to empower other youth to contribute to this collective and expand our reach beyond tennis.
